
HOLY EXPECTANCY

PREPARATION for WORSHIP ... preparing our spirit to be touched by the Spirit


- 1. Enter several minutes early...quiet the mind and heart

 - 5. Offer the sacrifice of Praise and Thanksgiving




The Fruit of Worship ...OBEDIENCE
